

# Income Tax Schools at The Ohio State University

Ohio State University offers income tax education designed for tax preparers with some experience preparing and filing federal tax returns for individuals and small businesses. We also provide tax education for beginning professionals and for farmer and farmland owners.

Instruction focuses on tax law changes and on the problems faced in preparing farm, individual, and business tax returns. Highly qualified instructors will explain and interpret tax regulations and recent changes in tax laws. Most schools and webinars offer continuing education credits for attorneys, CPAs, EAs, CFPs, and other tax return preparers.
